- **Date:** SPLASH is June 9-10, 2022.
- **Location:** The majority of our group will be placed at the host hotel (Marriott). However, we have also secured an overflow hotel (Hampton Inn) for a small group. Prior to June 9, we will confirm with all leaders who will stay at the overflow hotel.

 - Hampton Inn and Suite, Downtown Florence – 505 S. Court Street, Florence, AL 35630
- **Meals:** Snacks and meals are covered.
- **Hotel:** Incidentals must be guaranteed by individuals. Be prepared to provide a credit card upon registration.
- **Registration:** The registration process for SPLASH will take place upon arrival at the hotel. You will receive your conference materials at registration.
- **Transportation:** If you registered for transportation to and from SPLASH, the bus will depart the Support Hub (2601 Bransford Avenue) on Thursday, June 9 at 6:30 am and will return to the same location on Friday, June 10, no later than 6:00 pm.

Breakfast will be provided on Thursday morning, so plan to arrive by 6:00 am. Cars will be parked in a designated area at Bransford.

- **Attire:** Dress comfortably. Please wear tennis or comfortable shoes.

 - June 10 – Represent Your Tier – Shirts will be provided at SPLASH.
